

Auditing Degree Requirements

Degree Progress Report (DPR)

CaneLink has an option for students to audit their degree requirements. To do this, students can access their Degree Progress Report (DPR) and track their academic progress. To access the DPR, follow these two (2) simple steps:

STEP 1

After logging in to CaneLink, select the “Go to Student Center” button in the center panel.
